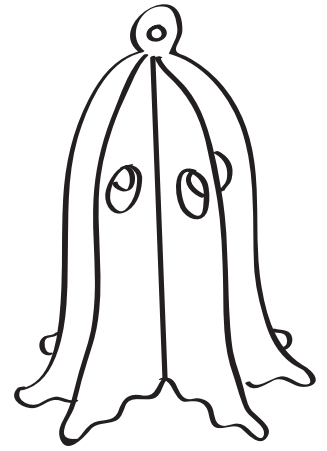

Hanging 3D Ghost for Flying Easel Cards by Karen Burniston

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print this sheet, making sure that Page Scaling is set to "none" in the print dialog box. Measure the square after printing to make sure it printed full size. (4" square)
2. Cut out the square. Paper clip or staple it to the same size piece of white cardstock or vellum.
3. Cut through both layers with detail scissors or a craft knife.
4. Slide Ghost #2 through the slot in Ghost #1 until the bottom notch is in the slot. Fold down the top of #2 to get it through the slot and then unfold on the back, locking the pieces together.
5. Slide Ghost #3 through the slots in Ghost #1 and #2 until the bottom notch is in the slot. Fold down the top of #3 to get it through the slot and unfold on the back, locking the pieces together.
6. Hang the finished triple Ghost using the top loop. If making a Flying Easel Card, use the Solid Ghost behind the triple Ghost as the Easel Stopper.
